

Publication requirements in the SzEEDS^M Doctoral Program

The Management of the SzEEDS^M Doctoral Program has identified the requirements such that they should be in harmony with the conditions of the publication environment in a realistic way. For each PhD candidate the following parameters apply.

- 1. The most important papers of a candidate should be published in English in an internationally ranked journal. Minimum two journal papers are <u>mandatory</u> of which
 - a) one paper is to be published in a Q1-Q4 journal as a mandatory item,
 - b) another paper is to be published in a Q1-Q4 journal as a <u>preferred optional</u> item, OR
 - c) another paper is to be published in a journal of the category A or B in the list of journals determined by any section of Department IX of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences (MTA) as an <u>alternative optional</u> item.

At least one of these journal publications should be co-authored with the candidate's supervisor(s).

- 2. As a complement to section 1 above, students can present a proof of two papers being at least in the first round of "under review/revise and resubmit" stage.
- 3. At least two conference paper versions are to be published in conference proceedings which have a Web-of-Science/Scopus categorization as mandatory items.

 All conference participations must be agreed with the Management of the Doctoral Program in advance.
- 4. As a substitute for a conference paper, an ISBN registered book chapter or a Scopus registered, published Journal paper can be optionally accepted.
- 5. Beyond the accomplishment of the required publication items, students may also publish in different types of publication forums.
- 6. All appeared publications should be entered into the MTMT (Repository of Scientific Works) by the students.
